Figure S1: Land cover classification of the IRBM according to Buchhorn *et al.* (2020).

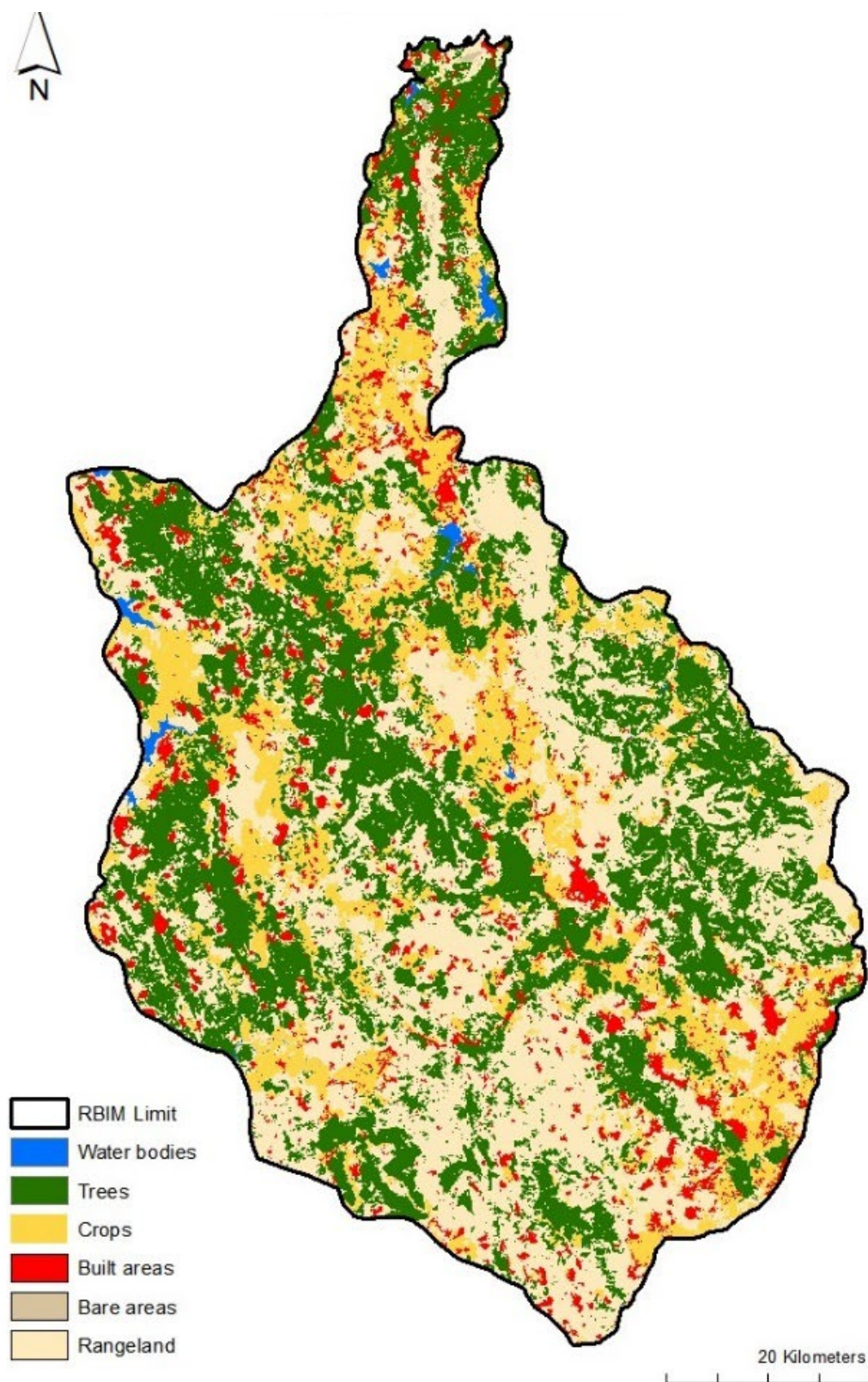
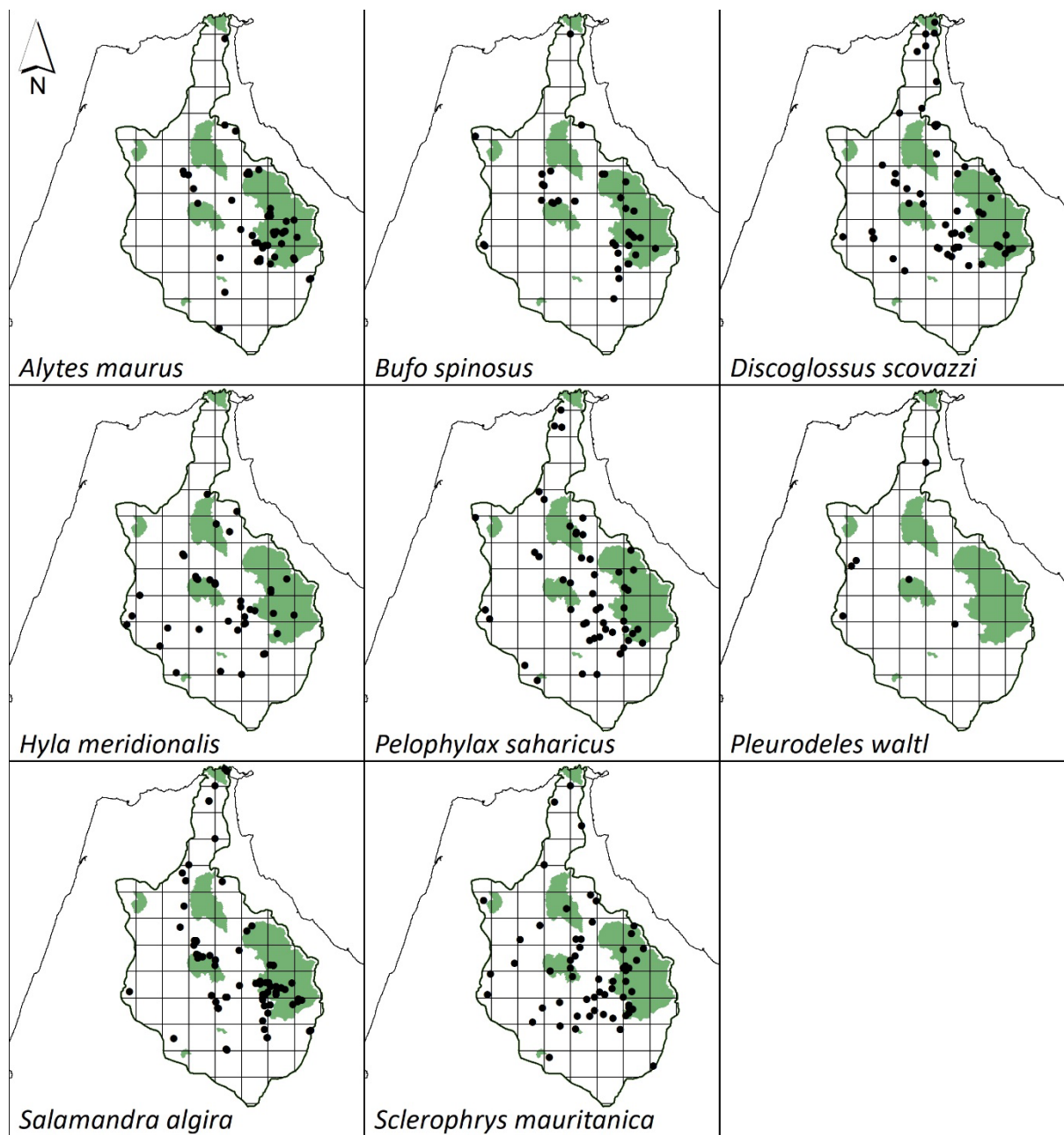


Figure S2: Distribution of amphibians and reptiles in the IRBM at a 10 x 10 km UTM grid.
